Grants News

Youth Sports Foundation of Tuolumne County

We are excited to support the <u>YSF's</u> goal of providing more sports & fitness opportunities in Tuolumne County with a \$1.5 million grant. More details about the project can be found on <u>MyMotherLode</u>.









Year End Grants

Two organizations were <u>awarded our</u> year end grants.



The Tuolumne County Sheriff's Posse was awarded \$20,000 to help with the Mother Lode Roundup Parade & Rodeo.

WATCH Resources was our second recipient, and received \$40,000 to support & integrate adults in our community with intellectual disabilities.



2021 Innovation Challenge

The Innovation Challenge was created to encourage NonProfits to step out of the day to day activities and develop a strategic plan and project. After delays because of the pandemic, we awarded funds to three organizations:

<u>TuCare</u> - increase fire resilience in Tuolumne County.

Youth Sports Foundation - increase sports and fitness opportunities in Tuolumne County.

<u>Sonora Chamber of Commerce</u> - create <u>Christmas Town Sonora</u> to encourage local shopping and increase holiday spirit.

Thanks to generous community support we were also able to award grants to every organization that submitted a request, including organizations providing mental health support.

We are happy to announce we have opened 3 new Funds:

- Todd Schroeder Young Artist Grant Fund
- Garside Family Adult Literacy Fund
- CNVC Fund

The Garside Family Adult Literacy Fund was started by the Garside Keitaro Matsuda, who lived with them in 1972 as part exchange student. Pat Garside's mentoring made a lifelong impression Matsuda wanted to ensure her spirit of encouraging literacy continued.

Tuolumne County Community Grants Program

In December, the County of Tuolumne partnered with the Sonora to establish a \$500,000 Community Grants Program to assist NonProfits and Community Groups that were affected by the pandemic.

- The organization had negative financial impact from the pandemic (loss of donations or funraising ability
- Provide services to communities impacted by the pandemic
- Enhance government services that benefit the community



Tuolumne County Board of Supervisors

The funds came from the economic stimulus bill passed in March of 2021.
